

**Timing:** AUG to MAR = most "campus culture" questions

I receive questions on my personal blog about USF year-round. I've been answering questions for about three years now, so I have a general sense of the high-time for the amount of

questions I receive.

Campus culture questions typically rise in August (a mix of brand new students and prospectives beginning the app process) and build through early/mid March (mostly prospectives by January - March period).
